

## **General information about the practical training at the Pharmaceutical faculty**

Practical training at the Pharmaceutical faculty for students is carried out in the 5th year of the 10th semester of full time educational and in the 6th year of the 11th semester of extramural study. It is common for both forms of study, namely:

- Practical training in Pharmaceutical Chemistry: duration 3 weeks.
- Practical training in organization and economics in pharmacy: duration 4 weeks.
- Practical training in Management and Marketing in Pharmacy: duration 3 weeks.
- Practical training in drug technology: duration 3 weeks.

These practical trainings are held on the basis of the communal enterprise "Boryspil Central Pharmacy № 24", which is located at the address: 08300 Kyiv region. Boryspil, 4 Shevchenko str.

During the practical training, students are required to:

- receive methodical instructions on practical training at the department;
- arrive at the base of practical training in due time, to present to the head of the base permit and methodical instructions, and proceed to the practice;
- fulfil all of the tasks provided by the practical training;
- follow the rules of internal procedure in force on the basis of practice, strictly adhere to the work schedule drawn up in accordance with the existing procedures of the enterprise;
- preventing shortening of the practical training to a reduction in working hours (regardless of the reasons, absences of practice days compensated by extending the term of practice with the permission of the dean's office and in coordination with the department);
- know and comply with occupational safety and health standards;
- be responsible for the results of the work performed;
- keep a diary of the practical training, for which 1 hour of total working time is allocated;
- submit a diary every day to your supervisors to check out your practical training from the department and from the practical training base.

Students also have the opportunity to pass the practical training in specializations that they choose by writing a statement stating the name of the practical training in specialization and at which department it will be held.

The following specializations are offered to students:

- "International Marketing in Pharmacy"
- "Pharmaceutical care with clinical pharmacy".

Responsible for conducting practical training in these specializations are appointed to the Department of Pharmaceutical Management, Clinical Pharmacy and Drug Technologies.

- "Medicinal plants and phytotherapy "
- "Quality control of medicines"
- "Chemico-toxicological analysis".

Responsible for conducting practical training in these specializations are appointed to the Department of Pharmaceutical and Biological Chemistry and Pharmacognosy.
