

SAFETY RULES

1. Make sure you are aware of the evacuation route out of the Center. Review the fire escape plan and the locations of fire extinguishers and first aid kits
2. In case of fire, you must immediately evacuate people, put out the fire and preserve material values
3. Make sure you know emergency phone numbers **101 (fire and rescue brigade)** and **103 (ambulance)**
4. Always work in properly-ventilated areas, especially if you work with volatile substances during a training
5. If you notice any unsafe conditions in the Center that may endanger health/life of a person or property's integrity, immediately report it to your teacher, course mentor or the head of the Center
6. Only materials and simulators necessary for work should be placed in the work area. Personal belongings should be safely stored aside
7. Never leave simulators or surgical instruments (especially needles, scissors and scalpels) unattended
8. Opening storages and taking out instruments and simulators is prohibited
9. Report any damage, malfunction and broken equipment immediately, even if the case seems minor or insignificant
10. If you are injured, call for help immediately
11. Any attempts to solve the problem with the equipment (simulators, surgical instruments, etc.) on your own are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**
12. Always follow the proper procedures for disposing of expendable materials. You can learn more about them at the Center's information stand or by asking your teacher
13. Last person to leave the lab must make sure that all the doors and windows are locked and the power sources are switched off
