When submitting several abstracts from one author, please add a serial number at the end of the title (for example, "Ivanova AA-1")

Forms of participation in the conference:

- 1. Oral PPT presentation with publication of the abstract.
- 2. Publication of abstract only.
- 3. Listener (offline at the Main Campus or Polish Campus of Kyiv Medical University).

Requirements for presentations

The presentation should be made in a .pptx in 2 languages: English and Ukrainian (presentation will be demonstrated in 2 languages simultaneously). Duration of the presentation is 7-10 minutes.

Requirements for abstracts

- ✓ Abstracts should be 1-2 full pages in length
- ✓ A4 pages with 2 cm margins; font Times New Roman, 14 points, 1.0 spacing, no hyphenation, width alignment), without figures and graphs. The title of the abstract is in capital letters, alignment is in the middle, font is bold, on the next line the name(s) and initials of the author(s) (bold), on the next line the name of the place of work or study, city, country (italic). Then email of the author. Next line the scientific degree and name of the supervisor (bold).
 - If the authors of the abstracts are from different institutions, please indicate their place of study/work with numbers (after the names and before the name of the institution).
- ✓ The abstract should be structured (introduction, purpose, materials and methods, results, conclusions, *keywords*). The list of references is drawn up in accordance with the American Medical Association 11th Edition.

The author is solely responsible for the content of the submitted materials, the accuracy of the results and the observance of intellectual property rights. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to refuse publication if the submitted work does not meet the requirements.

The authors will be notified of the acceptance of the materials by e-mail.
